### **Updates**

### **Suggestions**

- Neighbors in attendance requested additional EDPE signage to be purchased for entryways to the neighborhood.
- For neighborhood large item pick up day it was requested that teams of people be formed to assist neighbors in moving large items to their curbs; to involve local girl/boy scouts in this volunteer effort and to contact local non-profits to pick up items that are reusable prior to the city picking them up and disposing of them as trash.
- That bylaws and board positions be posted on website for nomination/election purposes.
- That a community safety forum be co-hosted with District 5 councilwoman, Stacy Mungo, for updates on local crime and marijuana dispensary.
- That meeting information be sent out via email and not as a calendar invitation to avoid date/time confusion with various types of computers/software/settings.
